In August I spent a month in Indonesia, principally Bali, getting to know the culture and the wonderful people. Though I'd come to Bali with a main interest being the highly promising <a href="Vortex hydro-power">Vortex hydro-power</a> technology it wasn't really happening, so I spent my time working out of "Kafe" & getting to know the people pushing the envelope of sustainable innovation.

There are very few people really supporting innovation in developing countries, in Indonesia a notable exception are Ramp and Inotek whose course and mentorship program for young innovators I got to visit
